Qualifications:

- 1) A desire to share your spiritual gifts and home with others
- 2) A commitment to be flexible and cooperative in support of the Facilitator
- 3) Consistent in what you say and do
- 4) Friendly and hospitable

Position Responsibilities:

- 1) Provide a clean, quiet and comfortable space in your home on a weekly basis for the entire series, to be renegotiated for continuation at the end of that time.
- 2) Before guests arrive, attend to pets, children, TV, phone, etc. in such a fashion that nothing intrudes or detracts from the purpose and activities of the Spirit Circle.
- 3) Have a cassette tape player set up and available for use during the meditation portion of the gathering. (Having some quiet meditative music playing before and after the gathering will help create an atmosphere of peace and calm in the room.)
- 4) Set up simple refreshments (coffee, tea, water, cookies, etc.) before the gathering time in order to be ready to greet guests and regular attendees with a warm and ready smile.
- 5) Arrange chairs in cooperation with the Facilitator, making sure an empty chair is always available to represent the other people who are to come and join your Spirit Circle in the future.
- 6) Meet people at the door, show them where to put their coats and point out the restroom facilities.
- 7) Display a genuine interest in each person so as to create an atmosphere of love and acceptance for everyone. Introduce guests and other Spirit Circle members to each other by first names.
- 8) Wait until the guests have departed before cleaning up and rearranging the furniture.
